3. THIS PASSPORT, WITH ENDORSEMENTS FROM ALL CHECKPOINTS, WITHIN THE PRESCRIBED TIME, WILL INDICATE A SUCCESSFUL FINISHER AND WILL ENTITLE THE PARTICIPANT TO ALL FINISHER'S AWARDS.

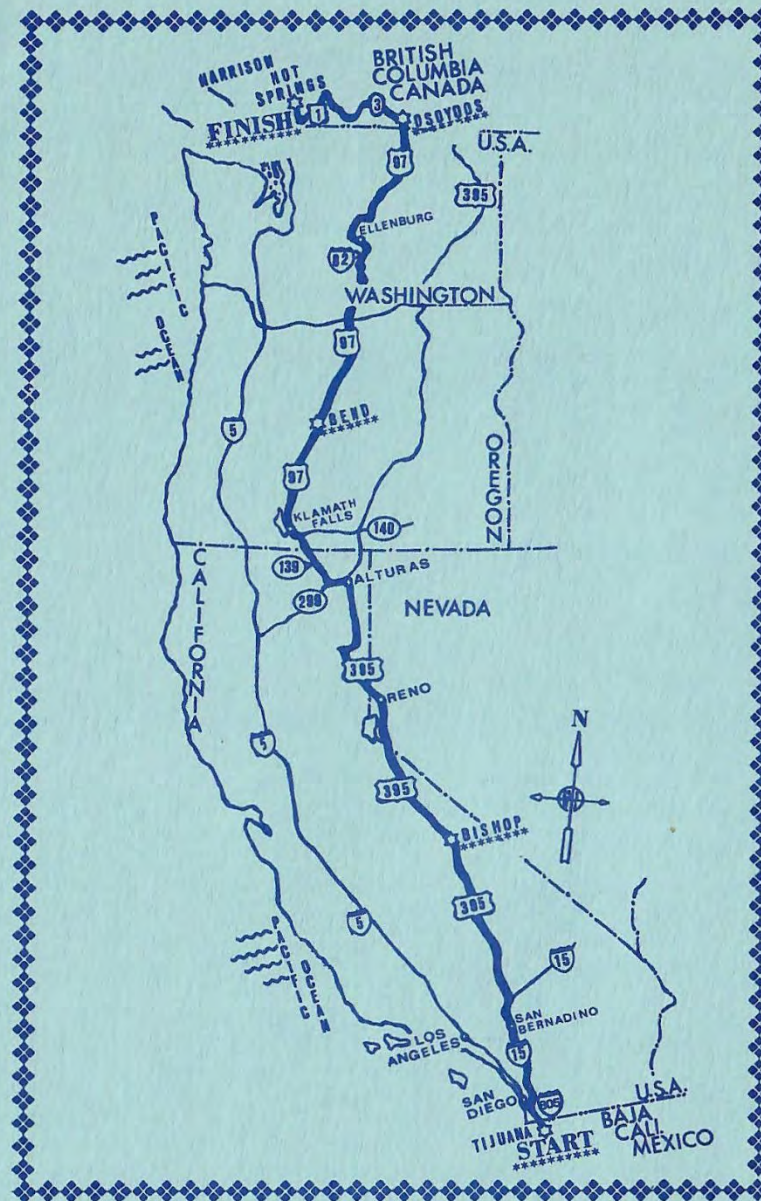

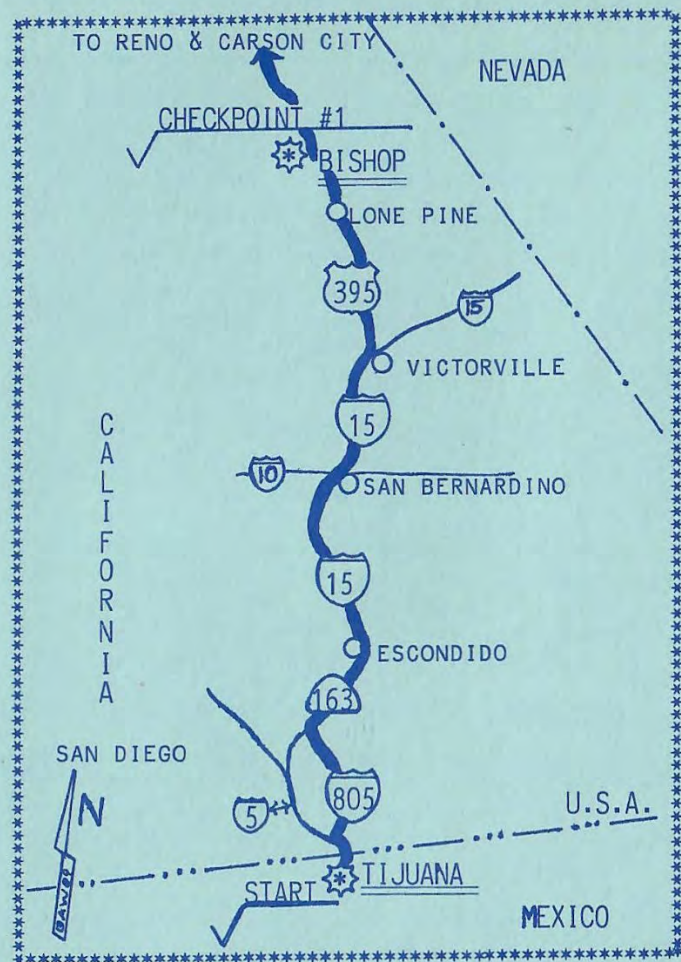

CHECKPOINT #1 IS 372 MI (600 KM) NORTHEAST OF TIJUANA, B.C., MEXICO. THE CHECKPOINT IS LOCATED AT:
BROWN'S TOWN CAMPING (619) 872-9561
SCHOBER LANE & U.S. 395 - 1 MILE SOUTH OF BISHOP. APPROX. ¼ MI BEFORE INTERSECTION BOTH STREET AND CAMPING SIGNS VISABLE. LEFT ON SCHOBER LANE AND LEFT INTO CHECKPOINT.

DESCRIPTION OF ROUTE TO FIRST CHECKPOINT
FROM THE SUN AND SEA DRENCHED AREA OF SAN DIEGO WE TRAVEL NORTH THROUGH A NEW FERTILE FARMING VALLEY FULL OF FRUIT AND CITRUS TREES AND UP AND OVER CAJON PASS TO THE HIGH DESERT AND A COOL NIGHT RIDE TO BISHOP. AS WE ENTER THE HIGH SIERRA MOUNTAIN AREA ON OUR LEFT WILL BE MT. WHITNEY, HIGHEST POINT IN THE 48 CONTINUOUS STATES. WEST OF BISHOP IS AN ANCIENT BRISTLECONE PINE FOREST; AT 4,000 YEARS OLD THE WORLD'S OLDEST KNOWN LIVING TREES.

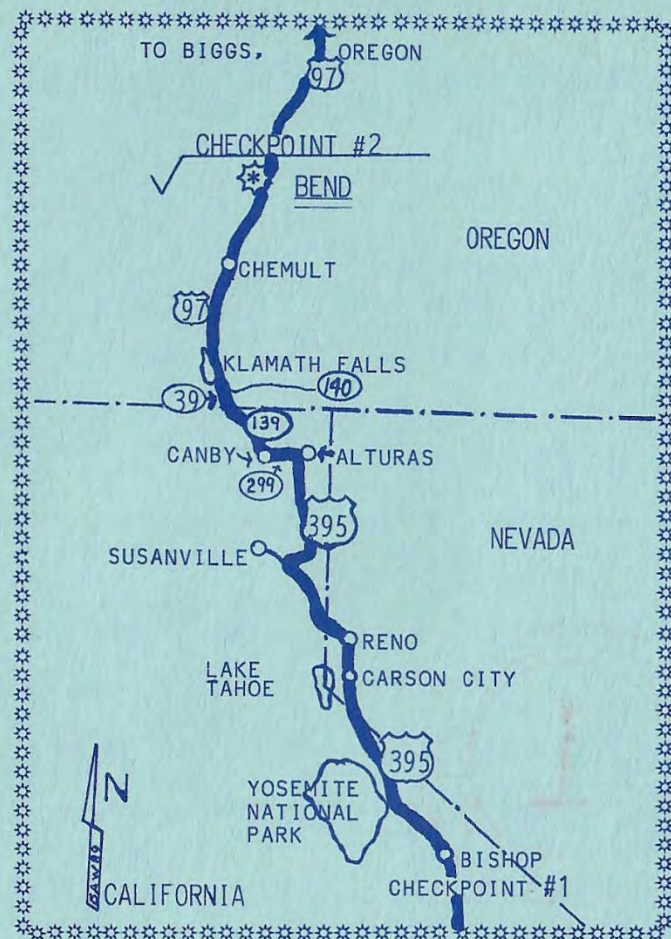

PARK AND MONO LAKE GUIDE US INTO NEVADA. CARSON
CITY WITH VICTORIAN HOUSES AND A SILVERY CUPOLA
ATOP ITS SANDSTONE STATE CAPITOL. EDGE BY LAKE
TAHOE TO PERPETUAL-MOTION GAMBLING AND VARIED
NIGHTLIFE IN RENO AND BACK TO CALIFORNIA, INTO
OREGON, THRU A SLICE OF LAND OF HIGH PLATEAUS,
DEEP CANYONS, PONDEROSA FORESTS, BROAD MEADOWS AND
GLITTERING LAKES.

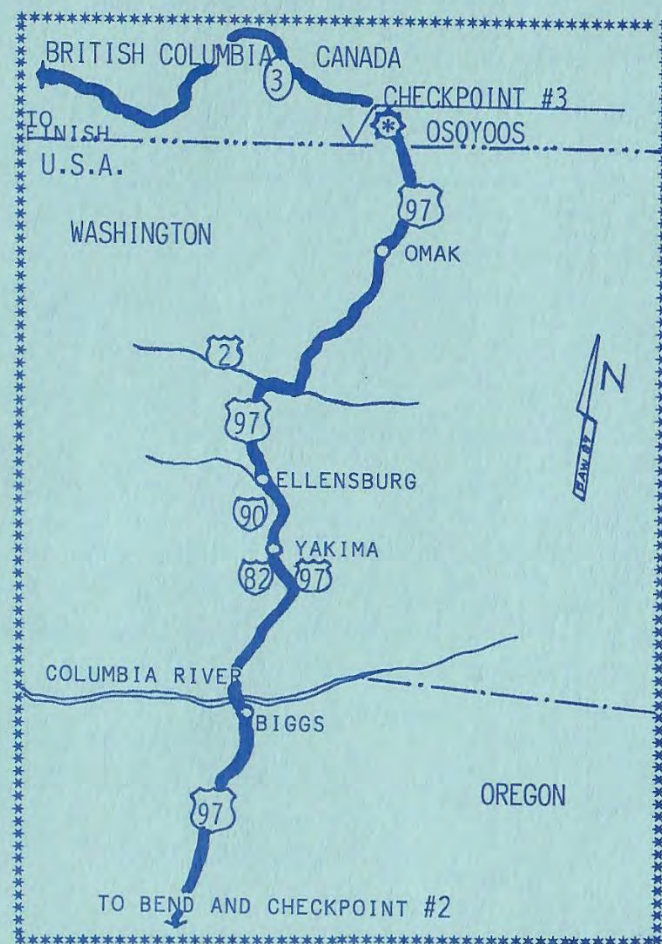

DESCRIPTION OF ROUTE TO THIRD CHECKPOINT
FROM BEND, OREGON, WE TRAVEL THROUGH CROOKED RIVER NATIONAL GRASSLANDS. MT. HOOD ON THE WEST AT 11,235 FT., IS THE HIGHEST POINT IN OREGON. NORTH TO THE COLUMBIA RIVER AND WASHINGTON WHERE WE TRAVEL THROUGH THE YAKIMA AND COLVILLE INDIAN RESERVATIONS. LITTLE PRECIPITATION REACHES THE LAND EAST OF THE CASCADES BUT THE FLOWERING FERTILE VALLEYS OF WILLAMETTE AND WENATCHEE AWAIT THE SENSES OF SIGHT AND SMELL. GRAND COULEE DAM, AN AWESOME MASTERWORK OF MASONRY, SPREADS THE WATERS OF F. D. ROOSEVELT LAKE 150 MILES TOWARDS CANADA.

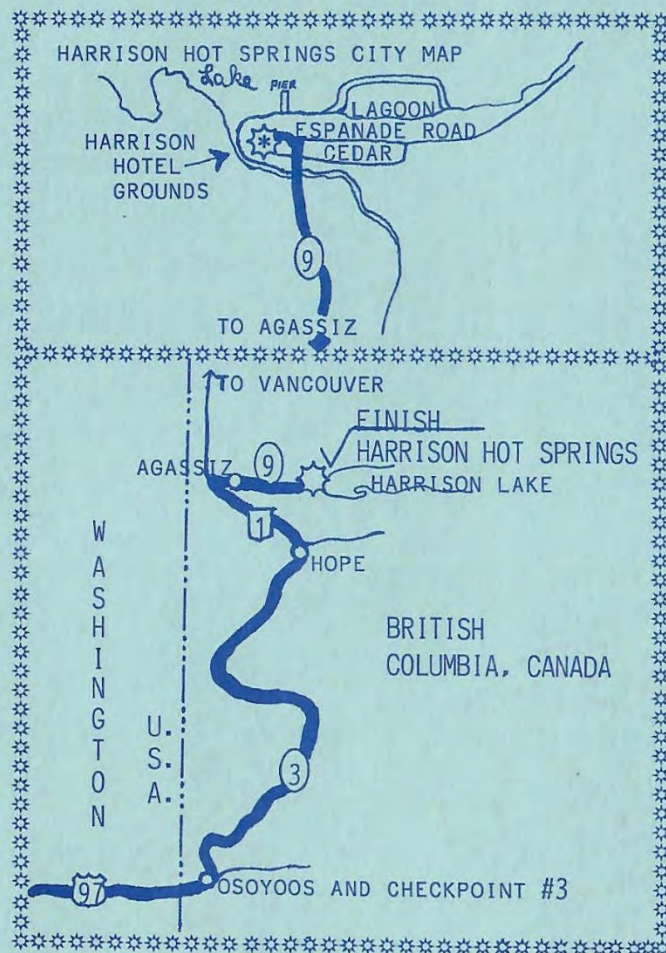
