

## **2017 Three Flags Classic Information - eBlast #5 - May 23, 2017**

Greetings Riders!

Hope everyone enjoyed the May long weekend as much as I did. I'm thinking summer may have finally arrived here in Canada. Yahooo.

This eBlast is going to discuss the GPS route details file, checkpoint locations and registration closing details for 3FC17.

### **REGISTRATION**

- Registration will remain open until July 31<sup>st</sup> this year.
- The T-shirt order is going to be placed on June 1<sup>st</sup>.
- Therefore, the only way you'll be sure of getting the shirt you want is to be registered by May 31<sup>st</sup>.
- Anyone registering between June 1<sup>st</sup> and July 31<sup>st</sup> (late people) will still get a T-shirt but it may not be the right size or sleeve length.
- And for these late people, the T-shirts will be given out on a first come first serve basis at the registration in Abbotsford.

As of this morning, there's only room for about forty more riders so if you haven't signed up yet, this would be an excellent time to do it.

### **CHECKPOINTS**

#### **Hood River, OR - Chk #1**

Hood River, Oregon

This checkpoint is just after getting off the Hood River Bridge and in the parking lot adjacent to the Hood River Motor Vehicle branch. (address noted)

#### **Winnemucca, NV - Chk #2**

1098 Fairgrounds Road  
Winnemucca, Nevada

This checkpoint is another parking lot that's close to the fairgrounds and service buildings.

### **Kanab, UT - Chk #3**

Kanab, Utah

This checkpoint is at a local tourist information centre in downtown Kanab.
