Join us for the newest twist on our Alien themed tours! This year we will mostly ride in California with a stint in Nevada. On our way to the California border, we will stop at the Atomic Cannon in Yuma, then once in California we'll visit Coyote's Flying Saucer Repair Shop and the Integratron in Landers. We'll then head into Death Valley and then end our ride at the Atomic Inn in Beatty, NV. Definitely an out of this world adventure!

The difficulty level of this ride is **ADVANCED**. This ride will have a moderate but entertaining sport touring pace with roads providing a challenge. Be prepared for cool temperatures in the morning, hot

temperatures later in the day and long days in the saddle with limited stops to eat. Bring snacks and hydrate yourself! This will be a great ride for intermediate/advanced touring riders as well as cruisers and people riding two-up. Roughly 800 miles total.

Start Location: GO AZ Motorcycles Peoria

End Location: Atomic Inn, Beatty, NV

### Itinerary

Day 1: 452 miles. Your mileage may vary.

Meet at GO AZ Motorcycles Peoria at 7:30 AM for ride check in. At around 7:45 we'll have a mandatory rider's meeting with side stands up around 8:00.

We will play it by ear for our lunch stop today, will probably grab a quick bite at an extended gas stop in Yuma near a photo op at the Atomic Cannon.

We will be stopping at Coyote's Flying Saucer Repair Shop for roughly an hour:

We will then head north towards the Palm Springs area through the Anza-Borrego Desert State Park via the Pines to Palms Highway.

We will depart the hotel at 9:00 AM. Please be fed and fueled!

Our first stop of the day will be the Integratron at:

2477 Belfield Blvd, Landers, CA, 92285, USA

The Integratron is located in Landers, California, 20 miles north of Joshua Tree National Park. Its creator, George Van Tassel (1910-1978), claimed that the structure is based on the design of Moses' Tabernacle, the writings of Nikola Tesla and telepathic directions from extraterrestrials. This one-of-a-kind 38-foot high, 55-foot diameter, all wood dome was designed to be an electrostatic generator for the purpose of rejuvenation and time travel. If you would like to book a sound bath, you will need to do it soon, space is limited!

We will then head into Death Valley and enjoy the great roads and scenery!
