Three Flags Classic PRE-RIDE



Hello Three Flag Riders!

Many of you know this and some of you may not. Every year two people pre-ride the Three Flags Classic Route. Their job is to:

- 1) Ensure the roads and route we have selected are not only passable, but in good condition and not under construction.
- 2) To write down the turn-by-turn directions and measure the distance between each turn. The better the route sheet the easier it is for people to stay on the route, or back-track if they miss a turn. (Not everyone uses GPS)
- 3) Give advice of rerouting a section of the ride in the event there are roads that are questionable.

The pre-ride journey is done in a car, NOT on a motorcycle. One drives and the other is a scribe.

The pre-ride team is reimbursed for hotel stays, gas and food. Steve Andrus, who lives in northern California is available between July 5 and July 15. He has ridden Three Flags a bunch of times. I'm looking for a second person to assist Steve on the pre-ride. We normally do this ride in April, May, or June, but as you know, everything is different this year. We prefer the team to share a room. Reach out to hotels on the hotel list for deals. They may or may not provide preferable rates but please ask.
