Dear USA Four Corners Rider,

I welcome you to one of the Southern California Motorcycling Association's most popular tours – the USA Four Corners Tour!

You will be riding the second longest running long distance riding tour that SCMA offers. Please take a moment to read the history of this tour online at [Four Corners History](#). You will see who and when this ride started and how the corner cities were selected.

Many of our members have ridden this tour multiple years and one member, Chuck Marble, has completed the True X option six times consecutively in one year. Another member, Charlie Lamb, has completed the USA4C over 15 times, riding it at least once in every calendar month. It does snow in the northeastern corner of the US from November to March. Over 2,000 members have finished the ride. I can assure you; every rider has a different experience and stories to tell about their ride!

You have a choice of two different options for your tour – Traditional and True X.

- You may start at any of the Four Corner cities of the United States: San Ysidro, CA; Blaine, WA Madawaska, ME; and Key West, FL, using any route and sequence you desired. You do not have to return to the first corner to finish the event.
- The True X was introduced in 2011. Ride your motorcycle from one of the Four Corners of the United States to the geographical center of the USA at Lebanon, Kansas. Then, ride to one of the remaining three corners and back to Lebanon, Kansas. Then ride to one of the two remaining corners and then back to Lebanon, Kansas, and finally ride to the fourth corner to complete the ride.
- You must comply with all the rules for the Traditional or True X rules at [Four Corners Rules](#).

Your **Ride Chairs for this Tour are Rodney Chew and Charlie Lamb**. The former Ride Chair, **Dannie Fox**, is a longtime member of the SCMA who held many positions and has ridden this tour many times.

Be sure and visit the [Madawaska Four Corners Park](#). Joe and Diane LaChance built the park in honor of this ride.

The USA Four Corners – Traditional Tour 21 Days or Less

The original USA Four Corners Tour includes visiting each of the outer USA four corner cities in 21 days or less. They are Blaine, WA; Madawaska, ME; Key West, FL; and San Ysidro, CA. The SCMA has been offering this version of the tour for over 30 years. In 2011, we added a second choice: The True X in 26 days or less. When the True X is completed in 21 days or less the rider's name, city, mileage and motorcycle are identified in **gold** on the Finishers' list.

The rules of the USA Four Corners Tour for ride certification are simple:

1. Riders must complete the Tour in 21 days. The first day is the date on the first Dated Business Receipt (DBR) and the last day is the date on the last DBR;
2. You may visit the **corners** in any order you wish;
3. You need not complete the "box," meaning once you finish the 4th **corner**, you have completed the Tour;
4. At each **corner**, you must:
 - a. Take a selfie showing you and your motorcycle at a recognizable **corner** city landmark. Post Offices are always a good choice as they show the city name.
 - b. Get an automated DBR which clearly shows the corner city, date and time.
 - c. Take a photo of your DBR and your odometer at the business issuing the DBR. Photos should be large enough so your bike as well as the landmark are visible. When the rider arrives home, all photos will need to be submitted via the [USA Four Corners Certification Request](#) page or included in an electronic ride journal.
5. The SCMA will review the submitted documentation, and, if completed within the **21-day time limit**, the rider will be declared a **Finisher of The USA Four Corners Tour**. Your name will be posted to the Finisher's list on the website.

The True X – A Variation on the USA FOUR CORNERS TOUR

SCMA offers a second choice for completing the USA Four Corners Tour. The Traditional tour includes visiting each of the outer USA four **corner** cities in 21 days or less. The SCMA has been offering this version of the tour for over 30 years. In 2011, we added a second choice: The True X in 26 days or less. When the True X is completed in 21 days or less the rider's name, city, mileage and motorcycle are identified in **gold** on the Finishers' list.

The USA Four Corners Tour – TRUE X includes the existing four outer **corner** checkpoint towns plus **three visits to the geographic center of the United States near Lebanon, Kansas, the geographic center of the United States**. It is marked with a remote **stone monument located on Kansas Route 191**. Starting at the corner of US 281 and Kansas Avenue in Lebanon, Kansas, it can be reached by traveling 1.4 miles north on US 281 and 1.0 miles west on K-191.

The rules of the USA Four Corners True X Tour remain the same as the Traditional Tour except for these changes:

1. Participants have **26 days to complete the True X**. The first day is the date on the first Dated Business Receipt (DBR) and the last day is the date on the last DBR.
2. The True X must be completed in the following **pattern and order**: first **corner**; Lebanon, KS; second **corner**; Lebanon, KS; third **corner**; Lebanon, KS; and fourth **corner**.
3. Riders must visit each of **3 landmarks near Lebanon, KS**. Each visit requires the usual selfie with you, your bike and the indicated landmark and a DBR (w/ city, date, time)/odometer photo. For **visit one**, take a selfie at the **stone monument**. For **visit two**, the **Lebanon Cenex station**. For **visit three**, the **Lebanon Post Office or Visitor Center**. Photos should be large enough so your bike as well as the landmark are visible. When the rider arrives home, corner photos and photos with your DBR and odometer reading, will need to be submitted via the certification procedure on the USA Four Corners Certification tab.
4. The SCMA will review the submitted ride documentation, and, if completed within the 26-day time limit, the rider will be declared a Finisher of The True X USA Four Corners Tour. Your name will be posted to the Finisher's list on the website.
